



## Team Canada Application Form

This special form has been created for Universities and Colleges to apply to participate in the IPF University Cup.

A maximum of THREE schools may participate, with a maximum of 15 lifters (8 men and 7 women) from each school.

Participants are not required to have lifted at national championships, but some experience in CPU competition is required. Final selection of which schools will participate will be based on previous experience and accomplishments.

Please submit ONE application per school, listing your schools team members.

Final selection will take place shortly after the 90 day deadline. Each team will be required to pay a \$200 per athlete fee to cover the IPF fees, and contribute to the coaching fund.

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### REQUIREMENTS after selection:

- All athletes, coaches and officials must stay at the designated hotel. Arrangements are usually made by the CPU, and often require payment in advance. You will be informed of the complete hotel and contest details, as they vary from event to event,

- When possible, two team members must attend the opening ceremonies and all team members present are expected to attend the closing banquet.
- Weight class changes are not permitted after the final entry is sent in, 21 days prior
- The team coach has the final say as to a lifter's attempts.
- Any difficulties fulfilling these requirements should be presented to the CPU prior to your acceptance onto the team.
- By signing this application, you agree with the above requirements, and agree to read Sections 9 and 10 of the CPU Bylaws.
- If you set a CPU national record at a World Championship, you must complete the CPU Record Application within 7 days of the end of the Championships.
